Welcome to South Hill Revolution Soccer Club

The SHSC is a non-profit organization offering licensed professional training and development for youth soccer players from five to eighteen years of age. Since the introduction of Revolution Premier/Select program six years ago, SHSC has continued to grow and develop high quality soccer players and teams. With new Coaching Director, Greg Howes the Revolution program is looking to enhance its program by utilizing Greg's professional playing background as well as his work with the US National teams to teach his staff and players. With its professionally Licensed coaching staff the SHSC consistently places teams at the top of state leagues and tournaments. Through our youth academy program, we offer players ages 5-10 the opportunity to be trained and developed by former professional and USSF licensed coaches year round. SHSC also supports the local community by offering soccer camps, coaching clinics, public demonstrations and educational information to further promote the "Worlds Game". The Revolution program offers players age nine to eighteen with a 6-12 month committed professional playing experience. Younger players are encouraged to tryout and may be placed on "developmental" teams that participate in more competitive leagues than otherwise available. Each Revolution team will have a paid trainer that is licensed, experienced or has professional playing experience. This program is more serious than what you find at the Recreational or District level. By being part of our Revolution program players will be given the resources needed to accelerate individual and team development. Each team/player in the SHSC Revolution program will be offered the following:

- USSF Licensed, professional, experienced training
- Competitive league season
- WSYS State Championship Cup or Challenge Cup
- 3-5 sanctioned tournaments
- Indoor Soccer leagues and tournaments
- Exposure to Olympic Development Program, College Showcases and US National team coaches

As the Revolution strives to play at the highest level, player and teams that are not ready for the Premier level/commitment are still able to compete and train as part of our program. Our goal is to offer high level specialized training to any and all players that are looking to learn from qualified coaches. These teams may still compete at the District level.

Team Fees include:

- Registration
- Uniforms
- Coaching Fee
- Referees
- Tournaments
- Field usage

Fees do not include travel expenses or extra tournaments and leagues chosen by the team.
